

Bolt, Bushing, Nut, and Link Rebuild

Installation Instructions

Caution:

- Always use precaution when working around any equipment.
- Always wear safety glasses.
- Follow skidsteer manufacture's safety guidelines when installing this product.
 - 1. Read all instructions prior to installation.
 - 2. Refer to track mounting instructions for safety precautions and torque specifications.
 - 3. Verify that all of the parts are included in the rebuild kit.
 - 4. Insert a bushing into both of the holes on each link.
 - **5.** Insert links into track pad. The offset side (1) on the link needs to be facing the inside center of the pad. See photo below for clarification.
 - **6.** Attach the links to the pad by inserting a bolt from the inside of the pad and tightening a nut on the other side. See photo below for clarification.
 - 7. Attach the other side of the link to the next pad.
 - 8. If it is necessary to use the inside holes (2) on the pad, only one end of a link can be attached to the inside hole of a pad. At least one end of a link needs to be attached to the outside hole (3) of a pad. Refer to mounting instructions for further clarification.

NOTE: Your pads and links may vary slightly from the ones shown on this page, but the same installation procedure will be compatible.
